**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN CHAPTER 330, P.L. 1997, TO PROVIDE  
STATE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM COVERAGE FOR ELIGIBLE RETIRED  
FIREFIGHTERS**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 330, P.L. 1997, provides for the enrollment of eligible retired Firefighters in the State Health Benefits Program (SHBP); and

**WHEREAS**, a qualified retiree under Chapter 330 is an employee from the Police and Firemen's Retirement System (PFRS) who:

- retired with 25 or more years of service credit; or
- retired on a Disability Retirement, and
- whose employer does not provide any payment towards the cost of retiree health coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey pays 80% of the premium for the lowest-cost statewide plan for eligible retirees and their dependents, with the retiree paying the difference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Bordentown Township Fire District No.1 wishes to comply with the provisions of Chapter 330, P.L. 1997, to allow eligible retired Firefighters who meet the statute's criteria to enroll in the State Health Benefits Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Bordentown Township Fire District No.1 in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Board of Fire Commissioners of Bordentown Township Fire District No. 1 hereby authorizes participation in Chapter 330, P.L. 1997, to provide State Health Benefits Program (SHBP) coverage for its eligible retired Firefighters.
2. The State shall pay 80% of the premium or periodic charges for the lowest-cost plan, and the qualified retirees shall pay the difference, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 330, P.L. 1997, and the rules and regulations governing the program.
3. The Fire District Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the New Jersey Division of Pensions and Benefits.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
